- cross stitch pattern -



Pattern information

Stitch count: 63 wide x 53 high

Design size (w x h): 11.4 x 9.6 cm on 14 count Aida / 28 count evenweave/linen
10.0 x 8.4 cm on 16 count Aida / 32 count evenweave/linen
8.8 x 7.4 cm on 18 count Aida

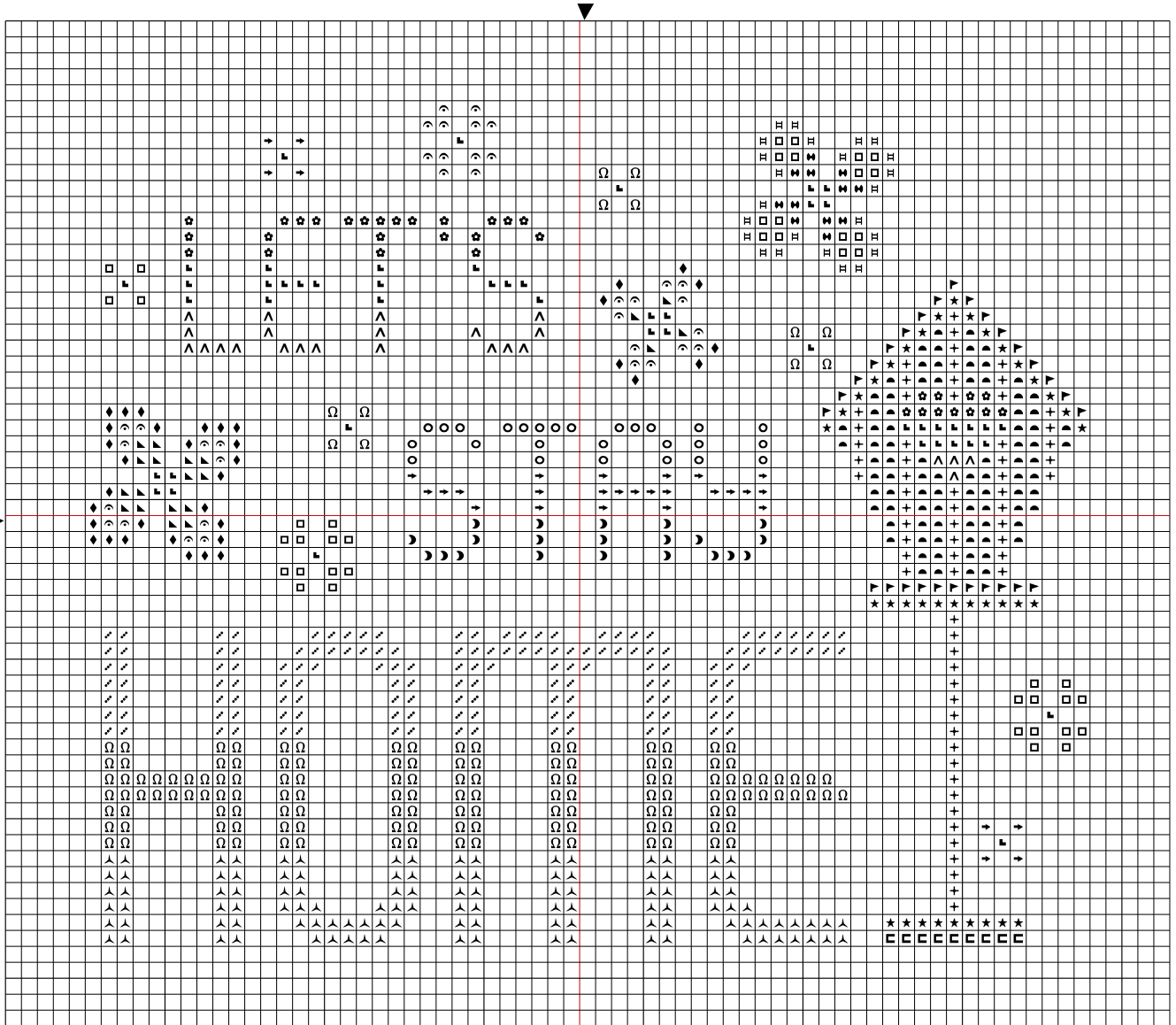
Thread used: DMC, 20 colours

Cover sample is stitched in 2 strands of thread on 16 count white Aida and framed in a 13cm (5inch) embroidery hoop

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Inspire me!

Ways to use your stitching

- create a cheerful piece of home decor for yourself or as a gift by popping it into a 13cm (5 inch) wooden embroidery hoop; this will be a tight squeeze if stitched on 14 count Aida but it fits perfectly when stitched on 16 or 18 count Aida
- turn it into a small hanging. Fold the fabric around a piece of mount board or cardboard, then glue or tape down the edges. Back with a piece of felt and add a loop of ribbon at the top.
- use just the birdhouse element to create a tiny 'new home' card or a tag for a present. Trim around the design 3 squares away from the stitching at each edge then fray the edges and patch onto a small card blank or gift tag.

Customising the pattern

- if you don't have all the recommended thread colours you can easily adapt the pattern to what you have in your stash. The flowers, birdhouse and letters don't need to be stitched in several shades; just stitch each one in a single colour; use either one from the recommended colours or any colour you like from your stash
- add beads in the flower centres instead of the yellow cross stitches for a touch of dimension
